<u>Note:</u> This is simply a guided discussion and sharing program, the information comes from the brethren. You are going to be asking the brethren assembled to share a story or experience they are comfortable with, where another Brother helped them or someone outside of our fraternity. This can be from saving a life to financial assistance or volunteerism.

<u>Required Research</u>: You might take some time to discover some acts of brotherhood or kindness and pre-solicit a member to help get things started.

The format for your presentation should be as follows:

<u>Instruction</u> – Discuss the topic for the night and a brief introduction

<u>Demonstration</u> –You can start by sharing a personal experience or one that you have presolicited.

Experience – The sharing itself will fulfill this part of the program.

<u>Assessment</u> – Ask the brethren to reflect on the importance of being Master Masons and why it is important that we are charitable and kind towards each other and those outside of our fraternity.
