Sum up with the "Conclusions"

The format for your presentation should be as follows:

<u>Instruction</u> – Discuss the topic for the night and a brief introduction

<u>Demonstration</u> – Show the brethren the Candidate Counselors Handbook, divided rituals, and full ritual. Then follow your outline and explain how our ritual started off and how it arrived where it is today.

**Experience** – Have the brethren share their feelings on the ritual. What it is like to experience it, view it, and memorize it. What would it be like if there were no ritual books, but only word of mouth? What if everything was put on video and no memorization was required?

<u>Assessment</u> – Ask the brethren their thoughts on the current format of the ritual and if they have suggestions for future improvements or clarifications.
