
# Welcome to the 26th annual Home Day!

# Honoring our Veterans

## Korean and Vietnam Memorial Monuments Dedication

At noon today in front of Bushnell Hall, Grand Master Terry W. Posey will conduct a dedication ceremony of memorial monuments honoring veterans of the Korean and Vietnam wars. There will also be a rededication of the World War I and II monument.

These permanent monuments are a tribute to those who served their country when called. The Grand Lodge of Ohio and The Ohio Masonic Home have a tradition of honoring veterans and is pleased to continue the tradition.

## "The Moving Wall" Vietnam Veterans Memorial

Springfield Masonic Community is pleased to have "The Moving Wall" Vietnam Veterans Memorial on display for Ohio Masonic Home Day. It is a half-size replica of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington, D.C.

"The Moving Wall" is dedicated to the 2.7 million men and women who served in the U.S. military in Vietnam. It lists the names of 58,253 people who lost their lives, and unaccounted for prisoners of war and those missing in action.

"The Moving Wall" is located in the parking lot next to the maintenance garage on Masonic Drive (see map on page 6), west of the Carl and Edyth Lindner Community Center. Shuttles from the main activities area to "The Moving Wall" will be available throughout Home Day. The shuttle pick-up point will be in the parking lot next to the corporate booths across from the home villa tours. It can be visited all day on Home Day and anytime through 4 p.m. Monday, June 7.

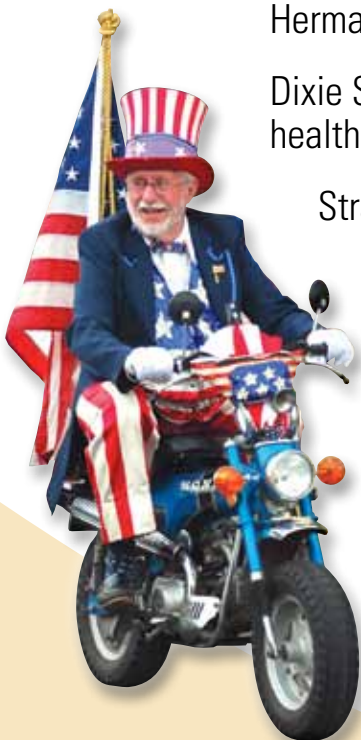

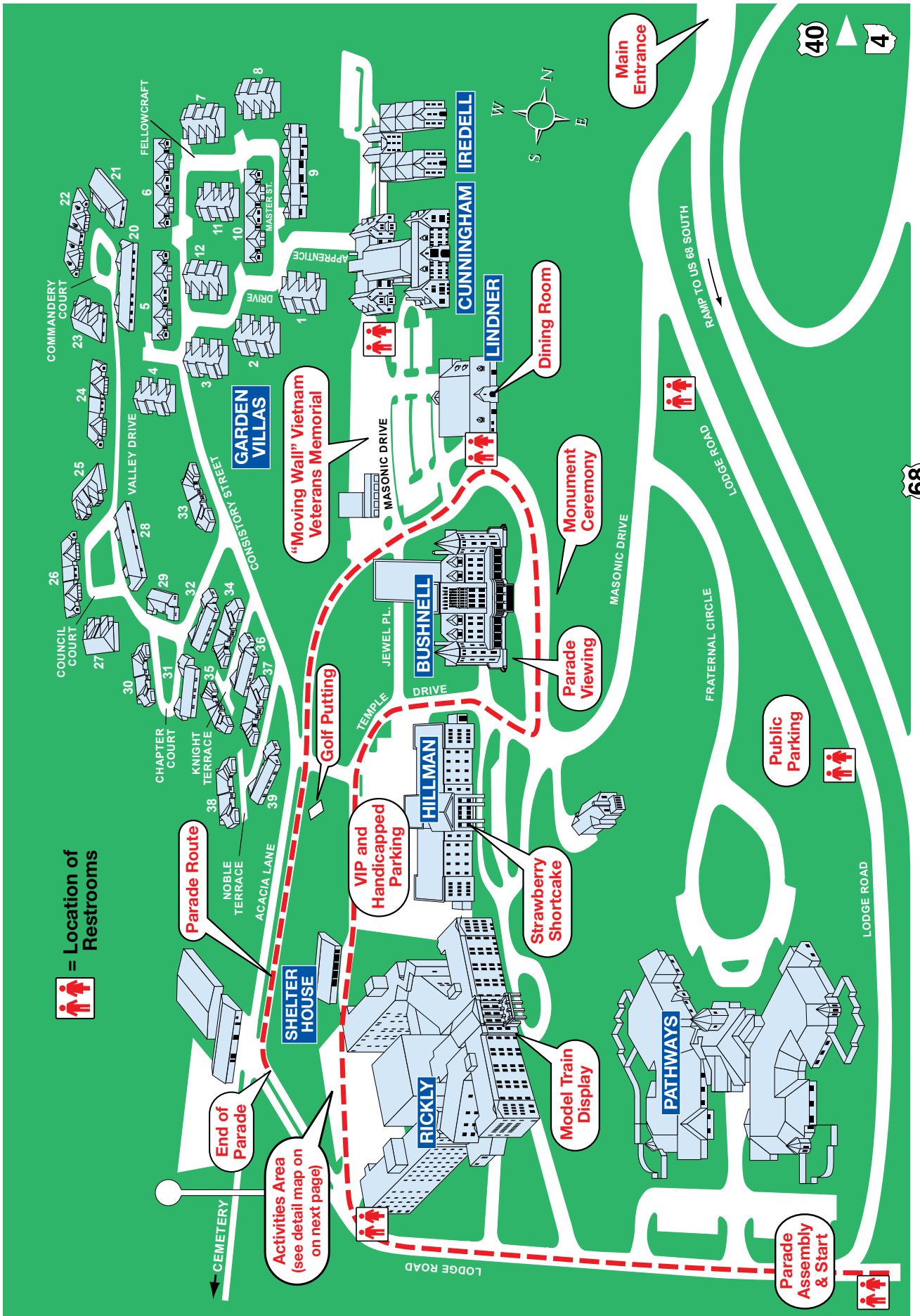

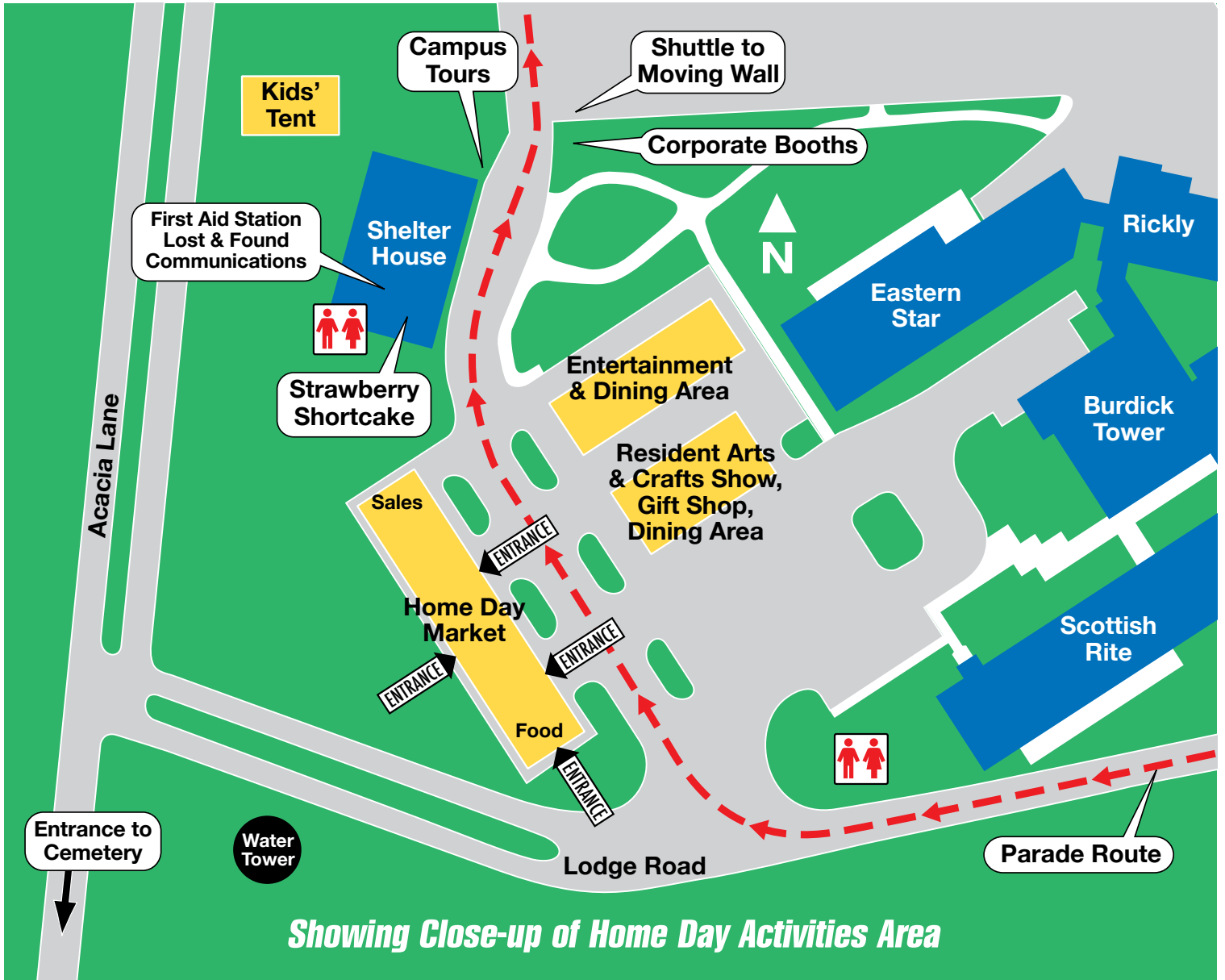
