Grand Master's Award Program - 2010

The following 10 items comprise the Grand Master's Award Program for 2010. Acceptable participation in 7 of the 10 items, as determined by the District Deputy, will be necessary to receive the Grand Master's Award. The period for consideration shall be October 17, 2009 through July 31, 2010.

1. * Suspension for Non-payment of Dues - Less than 2% of membership, not to exceed 10 (Membership based on 2009 Annual Return)
2. Candidates raised - Greater number than previous year
3. * Ritual - Two new lectures by members of the Lodge
4. Social activities - Maintain or increase number over previous year
5. Community service activities - Maintain or increase number over previous year
6. Publicity - Participate in the Grand Lodge program for the first time, or maintain/increase activity from previous year
7. Special Olympics - Increase donations over previous year by 5% (to a minimum of \$50.00), or make an initial donation of \$50.00 if lodge has not participated previously
8. Scholarship Foundation - same requirements as for #7
9. Charitable Foundation - same requirements as for #7
10. Masonic Model Student Assistance Program - same requirements as for #7
