

Major Jonathan Heart Service to Country Award



Major Jonathan Heart was Worshipful Master of American Union Lodge from 1779 to 1790. As such, he shepherded his Lodge through the close of its days as a traveling military lodge during the American Revolution and through the first years at its permanent home in Marietta, Ohio. Worshipful Brother Heart fell in battle at St. Clair's defeat on the Wabash, November 4, 1791, while serving his country.



This award is established as a permanent memorial to his supreme sacrifice—a sacrifice all service men and women face each day while protecting our country. Henceforth this award shall be presented by Ohio Masonic Lodges as a loving tribute to veterans of our country's armed forces.
